❖ 設置



電源コードの上に重いものをのせたり、コードが本機の下敷きになったりしないようにしてください。また、コードをねじったり、引っ張ったり、加熱したり、熱器具に近づけたりしないでください。コードが傷んだらご加入のケーブルテレビ局に交換を依頼してください。そのまま使用すると破損して火災・感電の原因となります。

- 押し入れや通気の悪いラックの中に設置する

本機は、2.4 GHz と 5 GHz の周波数帯の電波を利用しています。2.4 GHz 帯は、下記①に示すようにいるるな機器が使用しています。また、お客様に存在がわかりにくい機器として下記②に示すような機器もあります。

② 存在がわかりにくい 2.4 GHz を使用する主な機器の例

これらの機器と本機を同時に使用すると、電波の干渉により、通信がとぎれることがあります。

通信状況の改善方法としては以下の方法があります。

- ・電波が発生している相手機器の電源を切る。
- ・干渉している機器との距離を離して設置する。(本機を干渉している機器から離してください)

次の場所では本機を使用しないでください。双方向通信ができなくなる場合があります。

- ・本機以外の 2.4 GHz を利用する無線 LAN (IEEE802.11b/g/n)、また電子レンジなどの機器の磁場、静電気、電波障害が発生するところ。(環境により電波が届かない場合があります)
- ・ラジオからは離してお使いください。

使用範囲について

ご家庭内での使用に限りです（通信の環境により通信距離が短くなる場合があります）。

次のような場合、電波状態が悪くなったり電波が届かなくなるのが原因で、双方向通信がとぎれて、操作できなくなったりします。

- ・鉄筋コンクリートや金属の使われている壁や床を通して使用する場合。
- ・大型の金属製家具の近くなど。
- ・2.4 GHz を利用する無線 LAN (IEEE802.11b/g/n)、また電子レンジなどの機器の磁場、静電気、電波障害が発生するところ。
- ・集合住宅（アパート・マンションなど）にお住まいで、お隣で使用している電子レンジ設置場所が本機に近い場合。なお、電子レンジは、使用してなければ電波干渉は起こりません。

電波の反射について

本機が通信する電波には、直接届く電波（直接波）と、壁や家具、建物などに反射してさまざまな方向から届く電波（反射波）があります。これにより、障害物と反射物とのさまざまな反射波が発生し、電波状態の良い位置と悪い位置が生じ、双方向通信がうまくできなくなることがあります。このようなときは、RF リモコンや本機の場所、または無線 LAN アクセスポイントを少し動かしてみてください。RF リモコンと本機の間、または無線 LAN アクセスポイントと本機の間を人間が横切ったり、近づいたりすることによっても反射波の影響で双方向通信がとぎれたりすることがあります。

動かない画像を長時間映さないでください

本機に接続されたテレビやプラズマディスプレイに動かない画像を長時間映していると、画面に映像が焼き付いて影のように画面に残る恐れがあります。動かない画像を長時間映さないでください。

時刻設定について

本機では放送局から送られてくる時刻データに基づいて内部の時刻を設定しています。常に正しい時刻が設定されていますので、お客様に設定していただく必要はありません。

降雨対応放送

激しい降雨などによりケーブルセンターでの衛星放送の受信状況が悪くなり、番組が視聴しにくくなる場合があります。BS デジタル放送には、視聴に必要な最低限の情報を降雨に強い方式で送る降雨対応放送が用意されています。映像・音声かとぎれるようなときは、降雨対応放送を選ぶと、番組かとぎれることなく視聴できます。(降雨対応放送を行っていないチャンネルでは選べません。)

CAS カード (IC カード) について

- CAS カードは放送をお楽しみいただくための大切なカードです。CAS カードを挿入しないと有料放送を視聴できません。CAS カードは常時、挿入口に入れておいてください。
- 破損や紛失などのときは、ご加入のケーブルテレビ局にお問い合わせください。
- 本機では、CAS カードは「IC カード」と表示されることがあります。

CAS カード取り扱い上の注意

- CAS カードを折り曲げたり、傷をつけたり、変形させたりしないでください。
- CAS カードの上に重いものを置いたり踏みつけたりしないでください。

録画について

内蔵 HDD、USB-HDD、LAN-HDD に録画するときのご注意

※ 本書では HDD（ハードディスク）を HDD と表記しています。

- ホームネットワーク機器で録画予約を使用する場合は、スタンバイ設定を通常モードにすることを勧めます。
- ネットワークの通信が混雑していると、正しく録画できないことがあります。
- 接続している機器の性能や状態によって録画が停止したり、正しく録画できない場合があります。
- 録画時間が短いときは、HDD に保存されないことがあります。また、コンテンツやチャプターの編集で指定した時間の間隔が短いときは、編集ができないことがあります。
- 視聴年齢制限番組やコピー制御番組などの切り換わりで、録画番組が分割されることがあります。
- 内蔵 HDD および USB-HDD の時間指定録画の場合は、番組の切り換わり毎に録画番組が分割されます。
- 録画が禁止された番組は録画できません。
- 時間指定録画で録画中に録画禁止の番組が始まったときは、録画は中断されます。録画が可能な状態になると、再び録画が始まります。
- LAN-HDD の録画はダビング 10 には対応していませんので、1 回だけ録画可能な番組（コピーワンス）として録画されます。
- 内蔵 HDD または USB-HDD で連続した番組を予約録画したときは、次の予約の録画準備のため、前の番組の最後が約 10 秒切れることがあります。
- LAN-HDD で連続した番組を予約録画したときは、次の予約の録画準備のため、前の番組の最後が約 1 分 40 秒切れることがあります。
- HDD の残量が不足しているときは録画できません。
- HDD の電源がオフまたは USB/LAN ケーブルが抜けていると録画できません。
- 市販の DLNA 録画に対応した機器を本機に接続しても、正しく録画できない場合があります。
- 内蔵 HDD または USB-HDD の録画は、録画画質の設定にかかわらず、すべて一度「DR」で録画されます。その後、本機が録画などをしていないときに設定した録画画質に変換します。「DR」以外の録画画質で録画する場合は、「DR」で録画するときよりも一時的に大きな空き容量（残量時間）が必要になります。
- 音声多重番組を録画画質 2 倍～7 倍で録画した場合は、主音声のみ録画されます。再生時に音声を切り換えることはできませんので、副音声をお楽しみいただく場合は録画画質 DR での録画をお勧めします。

その他

- 録画機器の状態や放送内容の変更によっては録画できないことがあります。
- 放送時間の変更や番組が延長された場合、正しく録画できないことがあります。
- 予約した番組の前の番組が時間延長になった場合、予約を開始しようとしたときに、放送局から送られてくる番組の開始時刻の情報が正しく更新されないことがあります。このときは録画できません。

内蔵 HDD に関するご注意

お客様ご自身で内蔵 HDD を交換することはできません。

設置や使用するときのご注意

本機の設置場所や取扱に十分な配慮が不足しますと、下記のような症状が発生します。

- 内蔵 HDD が故障する
- 内蔵 HDD に録画した内容が損なわれる
- 動作が中断する
- ノイズが記録される

上記のようなことを避けるため、次のことを守ってください（9 ページ）。

- 下記のような場所には置かないください。
 - 本機背面の冷却用ファンや通風孔をふさぐような狭いところ
 - 本機前面の扉が開けられないようなところ
 - 傾いたところ（水平に置いてください）
 - 振動の激しいところ（衝撃や振動を与えないください）
 - 湿度の高いところ
 - 温度差の激しいところ
- 下記のような温度差の激しいところに設置すると、「結露」が起こることがあります。
 - 暖房をつけた直後
 - 湯気や湿気が立ちこめている部屋に置いてあるとき
 - 冷えた場所（部屋）から急に暖かい部屋に移動したとき

本機の内部に結露が起こったままお使いになると、HDDに傷がついて故障の原因になります。室内の温度変化は、毎時 10℃以下に保つことをお勧めします。結露がつくと信号が読み取れず、正常な動作をしないことがあります。結露をとるには電源を切り、結露がなくなるまで放置してください。そのままお使いになると、故障の原因になります。

- 電源が入っているときは下記にご注意ください。
 - 電源プラグをコンセントから抜かない
 - 本機を設置してある場所のプレーカーを落とさない
 - 本機を移動させない
- 本機を移動させるときは振動や衝撃を与えないください。故障の原因になります。

内蔵 HDD の初期化について

お買い上げ時、内蔵 HDD は初期化された状態ですので初期化の必要はありません。

- こんなときに初期化をします。
 - 内蔵 HDD 内の録画番組を削除しても空き容量（残量時間）が増えないとき
 - リセット操作をしても改善されないとき
 - 内蔵 HDD 内の録画番組をすべて削除し、リフレッシュさせたいとき
- 初期化するとすべての録画番組が削除されます。削除された録画番組は復元できません。
- 内蔵 HDD を初期化しても症状が改善されないときは、内蔵 HDD が故障していることがあります。症状が改善されないときは、ご加入のケーブルテレビ局にお問い合わせください。内蔵 HDD が故障した場合、録画番組の修復はできません。

USB-HDD を使用するときのご注意

- USB-HDD を本機に登録すると、本機専用のハードディスクとして初期化され、それまでハードディスク内に保存していた録画番組などのデータはすべて削除されます。削除したデータの復元はできません。
- 登録を削除した USB-HDD を本機で再び使用する場合、もう一度登録が必要です。この場合、登録時に初期化されるため、USB-HDD に保存していた録画番組はすべて削除されます。
- 本機に登録した USB-HDD で録画した番組は、本機のみで再生できます。他の機器にこの USB-HDD を接続して再生することはできません。

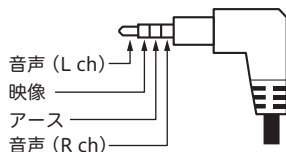

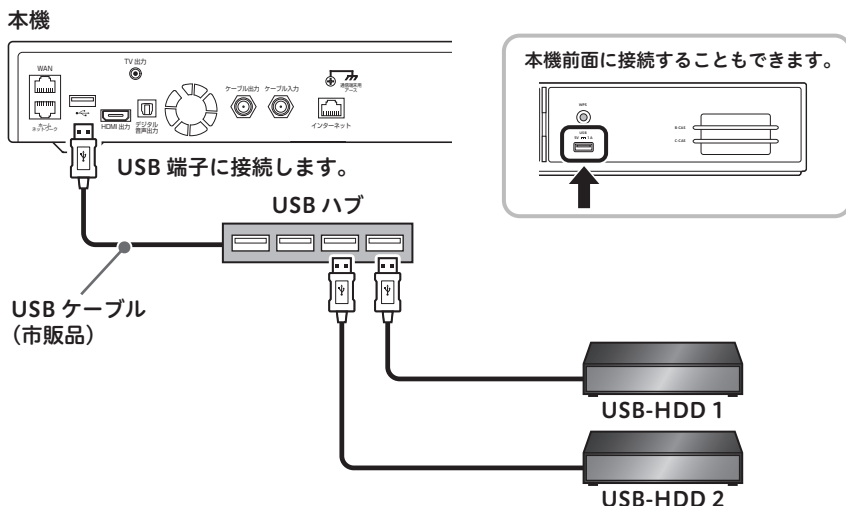

[This is the first released version of the Lesser GPL. It also counts as the successor of the GNU Library Public License, version 2, hence the version number 2.1.]

Preamble

The licenses for most software are designed to take away your freedom to share and change it. By contrast, the GNU General Public Licenses are intended to guarantee your freedom to share and change free software – to make sure the software is free for all its users. This license, the Lesser General Public License, applies to some specially designated software packages – typically libraries – of the Free Software Foundation and other authors who decide to use it. You can use it too, but we suggest you first think carefully about whether this license or the ordinary General Public License is the better strategy to use in any particular case, based on the explanations below.

When we speak of free software, we are referring to freedom of use, not price. Our General Public Licenses are designed to make sure that you have the freedom to distribute copies of free software (and charge for this service if you wish); that you receive source code or can get it if you want it; that you can change the software and use pieces of it in new free programs; and that you are informed that you can do these things.

To protect your rights, we need to make restrictions that forbid distributors to deny you these rights or to ask you to surrender these rights. These restrictions translate to certain responsibilities for you if you distribute copies of the library or if you modify it.

For example, if you distribute copies of the library, whether gratis or for a fee, you must give the recipients all the rights that we gave you. so that they can relink them with the library after making changes to the library and recompiling it. And you must show them these terms so they know their rights. We protect your rights with a two-step method: (1) we copyright the library, and (2) we offer you this license, which gives you legal permission to copy, distribute and/or modify the library.

To protect each distributor, we want to make it very clear that there is no warranty for the free library. Also, if the library is modified by someone else and passed on, the recipients should know that what they have is not the original version, so that the original author's reputation will not be affected by problems that might be introduced by others.

Finally, software patents pose a constant threat to the existence of any free program. We wish to make sure that a company cannot effectively restrict the users of a free program by obtaining a restrictive license from a patent holder. Therefore, we insist that any patent license obtained for a version of the library must be consistent with the full freedom of use specified in this license.

Most GNU software, including some libraries, is covered by the ordinary GNU General Public License. This license, the GNU Lesser General Public License, applies to certain designated libraries, and is quite different from the ordinary General Public License. We use this license for certain libraries in order to permit linking those libraries into non-free programs.

When a program is linked with a library, whether statically or using a shared library, the combination of the two is legally speaking a combined work, a derivative of the original library. The ordinary General Public License therefore permits such linking only if the entire combination fits its criteria of freedom. The Lesser General Public License permits more lax criteria for linking other code with the library. It also provides other free software developers Less of an advantage over competing non-free programs. For example, on rare occasions, there may be a special need to encourage the widest possible use of a certain library, so that it becomes a de-facto standard. GNU LESSER GENERAL PUBLIC LICENSE

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR COPYING, DISTRIBUTION AND MODIFICATION

0. This License Agreement applies to any software library or other program which contains a notice placed by the copyright holder or other authorized party saying it may be distributed under the terms of this Lesser General Public License (also called "this License"). Each licensee is addressed as "you".

A "library" means a collection of software functions and/or data prepared so as to be conveniently linked with application programs (which use some of those functions and data) to form executables.

The "Library", below, refers to any such software library or work which has been distributed under these terms. A "work based on the Library" means either the Library or any derivative work under copyright law: that is to say, a work containing the Library or a portion of it, either verbatim or with modifications and/or translated straightforwardly into another language. (Hereinafter, translation is included without limitation in the term "modification".)

"Source code" for a work means the preferred form of the work for making modifications to it. For a library, complete source

code means all the source code for all modules it contains, plus any associated interface definition files, plus the scripts used to control compilation and installation of the library.

6. However, linking a "work that uses the Library" with the Library creates an executable that is a derivative of the Library (because it contains portions of the Library), rather than a "work that uses the library". 7. Each time you redistribute the Library (or any work based on the Library), the recipient automatically receives a license from the original licensor to copy, distribute, link with or modify the Library subject to these terms and conditions. You may not impose any further restrictions on the recipients' exercise of the rights granted herein. You are not responsible for enforcing compliance by third parties with this License.
13. If, as a consequence of a court judgment or allegation of patent infringement or for any other reason (not limited to patent issues), conditions are imposed on you (whether by court order, agreement or otherwise) that contradict the conditions of this License, they do not excuse you from the conditions of this License. If you cannot distribute so as to satisfy simultaneously your obligations under this License and any other pertinent obligations, then as a consequence you may not distribute the Library at all. 15. The Free Software Foundation may publish revised and/or new versions of the Lesser General Public License from time to time. Such new versions will be similar in spirit to the present version, but may differ in detail to address new problems or concerns.

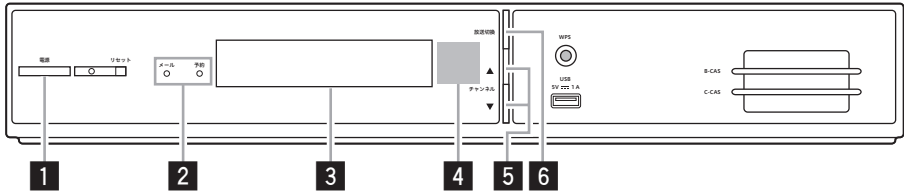
